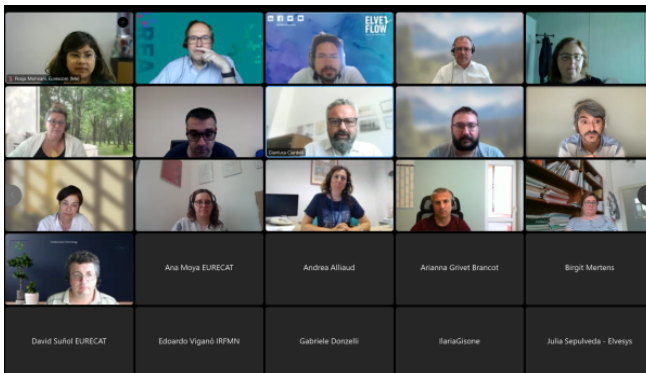


MPS World Summit

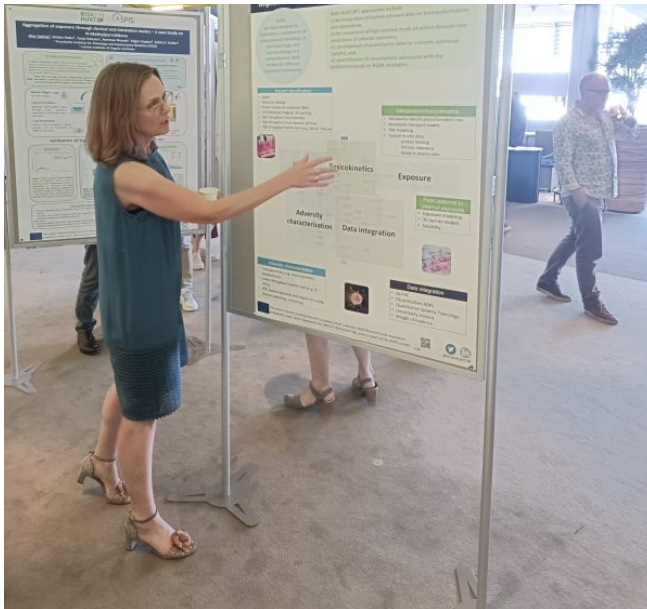


Project “ALTERNATIVE First Review meeting”
